The objective of NECSS is to develop, promote and coordinate speciality education activities in rural NSW using a collaborative approach.

### The Seminar

This seminar is run over two days with lectures until lunch followed by skill station and tutorial rotations in the afternoons. Participants will attend a skill station rotation on one day and a tutorial rotation on the other. Participants will be asked to indicate their overall level of experience in caring for critically ill patients and this information will be used to create two groups, experienced and novice. If you are unsure please email or ring ICCMU.

### Skill Stations & Tutorials

At present we hope to have nine skill stations (see list below) with information presented at novice and experienced levels. Each participant will rotate through FOUR skill stations only unless a specific request is made. This selection will be made at registration on day 1 of the Seminar. All participants will complete the tutorial rotations UNLESS a specific request is made not to. Tutorials will consist of three 20 minute lectures followed by small group work. Groups will be organised on the day according to skill and knowledge level.

#### The skill stations will be:

1. External pacing—Zoll
2. Ventilation—Mayohealthcare
3. Airway management—Covidien
4. PiCCO—Pulsion Pacific
5. Spinal stabilisation—Spinal CNC
6. Primary & secondary survey—TraumaCNC
7. Burns assessment & fluid management—SBIS educator
8. Paediatric fluid assessment—NETS educator
9. UWSD management—Covidien

1. Rhythm interpretation
2. Inotrope management
3. ABG interpretation
